



Euronet signs two large lottery chains in Germany for e-top-up solutions

LEAWOOD, KANSAS and MUNICH, GERMANY-December 7, 2005- Euronet Worldwide's (Nasdaq: EEFT) subsidiary, Transact, today announced the introduction of electronic top-up (e-top-up) services at the lottery outlets of Westdeutsche Lotterie GmbH & Co. OHG (WestLotto), the largest German lottery operator and Niedersachsen Lotterie, another leading lottery chain. Transact's e-top-up services will be available at a combined total of 4,500 outlets of the two lottery chains.
